### Minor Enhancements

<b>Account Manager</b>	
ECE-411	Improved and standardized the width of lines on multiple line charts for enhanced readability.
<b>Administrator</b>	
ECE-419	Updated company name and copyright information for the EnergyCAP Administrator program.
<b>Audit Manager</b>	
ECE-462	Audit 51 Logic enhancement. Caption Search now uses “LIKE” as a filter operator rather than “equals”.
ECE-444	The Audit 39 Average Unit Cost value for last year (comparison) is now being calculated correctly.
<b>Bill Entry</b>	
ECE-433	Bill Entry window no longer displays “0” values in fields where no data has yet been entered.
<b>Cost Avoidance Manager</b>	
ECE-465	Improved instant search for CAP Processor and Global Meter Update Place filters. Also for User Properties Security tab Topmost Place and Topmost Cost Center selectors and Account Wizard Vendor selector. Search is now updated each time a new character is added to the search field.
ECE-461	The Cost Avoidance Processor was enhanced to permit users with deregulated accounts to ignore supply accounts that are no longer being used when running the processor. Previously, the processor would skip a meter with a supply account but no bill for the account.
<b>Facility Manager</b>	
ECE-389	Updated the Facilities binoculars search to display search results for Meter Code, Meter serial #(s), Meter Display, Meter street address, Building Code, and Building Display, in that order. The Facilities search and results interface and functionality now mirrors the interface for the Account search.
ECE-437	Facility, Group, and Account Manager PowerViews were updated to ensure correct display of numbers in the billions.

ECE-422	Program copyright information was updated to 2011.

<b>Route Manager</b>	
ECE-372	Data display enhancement—updated Route Manager Readings window to display additional data (meter name, previous reading, previous reading date).
<b>User Manager</b>	
ECE-438	The Create User/User Properties window was resized to assure functionality at a 1024 x 768 monitor resolution.
<b>Work Flow Manager</b>	
ECE-415	Altered the Bill Export Wizard logic to improve the bill export process. Added Bill Created and Bill Modified date fields to the export. Corrected problems with using text delimiters.
ECE-263	Bill Splits logic has been updated to better handle multi-meter accounts when not all meter data is available.

<b>Account Manager</b>	
ECE-468	Bill images now display instead of generating a “Cannot display webpage” error.
ECE-460	The right-click menu kept re-drawing and was not usable. This has now been fixed.
<b>Audit Manager</b>	
ECE-430	Audit 42 now calculates as expected for seasonal rates.
ECE-399	Audit 31 was reworked and corrected to provide more meaningful unit cost information and to provide for high/low cost/unit tolerances.
<b>Bill Entry</b>	
ECE-457	A problem with spooling and printing of longer Bill Messages was resolved, and additional data was added to the printout (account, bill dates) to improve usefulness. A Print button was added to the Bill Entry/Bill Message window of the user interface.
<b>Budget Manager</b>	
ECE-455	A question regarding budget units of measure (common and native units) was investigated to confirm that the Budget Manager displays and saves budget usage values in common units. No code change was required.
<b>Cost Avoidance</b>	
ECE-241	CA module has been updated to prevent a Cost Avoidance adjustment zeroing out CA for a single bill in a series of billings for a single account for a single month from affecting Cost Avoidance processing of other bills in the same month.
ECE-443	Corrected a flaw in the Cost Avoidance processor that caused an understatement of the baseline in cases where (1) bill start/end dates straddled the baseline start date and (2) meter was weather-adjusted for that month and (3) the first or last bill in the baseline period was an outlier from the weather regression calculation.
ECE-407	An application crash error relating to Issue Tracker and Outlook email was resolved.

<b>Facility Manager</b>	
ECE-406	Restrictions on allowable content for the search field were relaxed to enhance functionality and ease of use.
ECE-357	Billed and Actual Demand values display correctly in the chart. The legend had the values reversed in a previous release.
<b>Rate Manager</b>	
ECE-431	Rate templates with longer names can now be saved successfully using a truncation process. The full name and version begin date are now saved in the template note field.
<b>Report Manager</b>	
ECE-458	The Report Distribution Manager has been updated to ensure that data view “topmost” permissions are consistently honored, whether or not an email recipient is an EnergyCAP user.
ECE-421	The “Web Reports” button didn’t correctly launch web reports if EnergyCAP Online was installed to a subdirectory of a web server. This has been fixed.
ECE-381	User filters are now preserved during report updates, and are not deleted unless the newer report no longer offers the filter option.
<b>Route Manager</b>	
ECE-436	An EAccess Violation error which occurred when editing meter/counter readings has been corrected.
<b>Spreadsheet Manager</b>	
ECE-432	For accounts with multiple meters, the GHG custom spreadsheet values were incorrect (duplicate rows). This has been fixed with a new custom spreadsheet template.
ECE-414	User Topmost permissions will be honored during the spreadsheet creation process.
ECE-410	Several custom spreadsheet template errors have been corrected. The “0 records returned” error has been fixed for the following templates: Meter Summary-Locate Account, Meter Summary-Locate Meter, Budget Export Data-Locate Meter. For Budget vs. Actual Summary-Locate Meter and Budget Summary-Locate Meter, Topmost Cost Center has been added as a filter and output option.
<b>Staging Tables</b>	
ECE-141	The thin client “Internet” connection has been modified to allow a longer timeout period so that databases with long-running staging table processes can complete in the background.
<b>Template Manager</b>	
ECE-331	Logic for bill entry template selection revised and simplified to help ensure that the relevant bill entry template is selected for bill entry based on the bill Start Date.
<b>Weather Station Manager</b>	
ECE-475	Canadian weather stations can now be automatically assigned for a building. An error with saving the station was corrected.

<b>Workflow Manager</b>	
ECE-426	The Bill Importer was updated to check for unique account codes when the (optional) Vendor Code field is missing. This will ensure that bill information is not imported into the wrong account.
ECE-425	(ACCTPERIOD field) A bill import issue relating to overwriting of account period data with bill batch data was resolved. The logic was enhanced as follows: IF there is an account column for Account Period in the import file, the Bill Import value will override the Batch value. If there is no column for Account Period, then the Batch period will be used. If the Batch has no value, then the Account period database field will remain empty/NULL.
ECE-423/424	A Bill Import issue relating to duplicate account codes (common to deregulated scenarios) was corrected.
ECE-385	Closing the batch will automatically run the audits selected in the Workflow Wizard.
